Inaugural President



Sir Thomas Henry Holland joined GSI in 1890 and became its Director after superseding several senior officers on 25th February 1903. He was only 34 years old. Besides, being instrumental in laying the foundation of Mining and Geological Institute he was responsible for organising the "Geology Department" of Presidency College and "Geology Section" on Indian Museum. He retired in 1909 at the age of 41 to accept Professorship of Geology at Manchester University. He came back to India later as Chairman, Indian Industrial Commission in 1916; became a member of Viceroy's Executive Council in-charge of "Industries and Commerce" in 1919-21. On his return to England he was Rector of Imperial College, Vice Chancellor, Edinburg University, Vice President Royal Society and many other learned societies. His interest in progress of geological research in our country remained till death on 15th May, 1947.

Mr. W H Pickering was the first Chief Inspector of Mines. He was an outstanding mining engineer and a capable administrator. At the Government level, there was only specialist in mining posted in GSI in 1894. Subsequent to 'Mines Act 1901' the mining was separated from GSI in 1902 and a new Department As "Bureau of Mines Investigation" was created. In 1904 the name was changed to Department of Mines which was shifted from GSI to Pretoria Street Calcutta and subsequently to Dhanbad. One wonder the zeal and drive of a top mining personnel of the Government to spare the energy to convene the meeting on 10 November, 1905 which laid the foundation of **Mining and Geological Institute of India**.

Profile of The Mining, Geological & Metallurgical Institute of India

Background Information

The initiative for formation of the Institute was taken by Mr. W H Pickering the then Chief Inspector of Mines in India. In his venture to form the Institute Mr. Pickering received encouragement and help from Mr. T H Holland, FRS, (later Sir Holland) the then Director of the Geological Survey of India. They thought that Geologists and Mining Engineers are brothers and it was natural that they should unite.

On 16th January, 1906, the Inaugural Meeting was held at Chotanagpur Mounted Rifles Club, Asansol. Mr. T H Holland, the Director, Geological Survey of India, was elected the first President of the Institute and Mr. W H Pickering, the Chief Inspector of Mines, was elected the first Hony. Secretary.

The Institute was incorporated under the Indian Companies Act, 1882, on the 16th September 1909. By a special resolution in an Extraordinary General Meeting of the Members of the Institute held on 22nd October 1937, the word "Metallurgical" was added in the Institute's name and thus the Institute was renamed as "The Mining, Geological & Metallurgical Institute of India (MGMI)".

Purpose and Scope of the Institute

The Institute was established with the object of promoting "the study of all branches of mining methods and of mineral occurrences in India, with a view to disseminating the information for facilitating economic development of the mineral industries in the country". The Institute has been recognized as a Scientific and Industrial Research Organisation (by the Department of Scientific and Industrial Research, Govt. of India) through which the technical and scientific community could, to their mutual benefit, discuss fully the problems which would continuously arise in the mineral industry.

Objectives

To advance and protect the interest of the mineral industries and the welfare of those engaged therein and to assist maintaining an honourable practice in the professions of Geology, Mining, Metallurgy and allied subjects connected with the mineral industry of the country.
